- ALL ACLS Renewal Courses will include **BLS** certification.
- Course time is <u>8:00am-5:30pm</u>
- Students <u>MUST</u> bring <u>current</u> BLS & ACLS cards, a printed pre-test, and an ACLS Provider Manual to class with them.
- You will NOT be permitted into the class if your BLS or ACLS has expired.
- This course is indicated for health care providers who have current ACLS & BLS cards.
 - Anyone with an expired ACLS card MUST take the two-day First-Time Provider Course.
 - Anyone with an expired BLS card MUST first take a BLS course.
- The Pretest MUST be completed prior to class and scores MUST be printed and brought to class.
- If you are not able to attend once registered, it is your responsibility to cancel in a timely fashion.
