Middleburg Heights, OH (*March 24, 2020***)** – In response to the ongoing COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, Southwest General announces the following changes:

NEW VISITOR POLICY: EFFECTIVE TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 2020

ALL VISITORS WILL BE SCREENED

NO VISITORS ARE ALLOWED TO SEE PATIENTS:

- Confirmed with COVID-19 or persons under investigation (PUI) for COVID-19
- On any general medical/surgical floor

VISITORS ARE ALLOWED TO SEE THE FOLLOWING PATIENTS, WITH THE STATED RESTRICTIONS:

- Pediatric/Maternity patients: the *same* one adult visitor for the duration of mom's hospital stay, including overnight
- Surgical patients: one visitor for day of surgery
- Ambulatory Health Centers, physician offices, ER: one visitor

OUTPATIENT AND ELECTIVE PROCEDURES:

- IMAGING/LAB TESTING
 - ONLY emergency imaging procedures will be performed at our Main Campus.
 Elective procedures will move to our offsite locations (Brunswick and Strongsville Medical Centers)

THERAPY SERVICES:

- Therapy Services have relocated from the hospital's Main Campus to one of our offsite locations
- All patients arriving for care will be screened

NEW PATIENT DISCHARGE LOCATION

Patients being discharged from the hospital should now be picked up at the entrance to Building B on our Main Campus. This is effective immediately.

For special requirements, including end-of-life situations, individuals should ask to speak with the Chief Nursing Officer or Chief Medical Officer.
